**ORDINANCE NO. 6-s.2021**

**AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING MUNICIPAL-WIDE CURFEW HOURS FROM TEN IN THE EVENING (10:00 P.M.) TO THREE IN THE MORNING (3:00 A.M.) IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF CALAMBA, MISAMIS OCCIDENTAL AS A MEASURE TO ADDRESS THE CONTINUOUS THREAT OF TRANSMISSION OF THE COVID-19 DURING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MODIFIED GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE (MGCQ).**

**WHEREAS**, on March 8, 2020, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte issued proclamation No. 922 declaring a Public Health Emergency throughout the Philippines due to Covid-19;

**WHEREAS**, on May 20, 2021, the National Inter-Agency Task Force (NIATF) against Covid-19 issued the Revised Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines;

**WHEREAS**, on May 29, 2021, Governor Philip T. Tan of the Province of Misamis Occidental issued Executive Order No. 42-s-2021, "An Order Adopting the Applicable Provisions in the Revised Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines dated May 20, 2021, in the Province of Misamis Occidental. As stated in Section 17, all cities and municipalities of the Province are hereby advised to harmonize its curfew hours from 10:00 o'clock in the evening up to 03:00 o'clock in the morning;

**WHEREAS**, as of June 1, 2021, the Municipality of Calamba has already 102 confirmed cases of Covid-19 infections, 19 active cases, 2 deaths, and 81 recovered;

**WHEREAS**, in the interest of public order and safety and one of the important measures to prevent the spread of the virus, there is a need to pass legislation of a temporary nature imposing curfew for all residents of the Municipality during the modified general community quarantine (MGCQ);

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to strike a balance between the promotion of health by limiting the non-essential movement of the people and the promotion of economic activities which are both

essential to the welfare and well-being of the people by aligning the curfew hours to the needs of the time;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** as it is hereby ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Calamba, in session duly assembled, THAT:

**SECTION 1. TITLE.** This Ordinance shall be known as **“AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING MUNICIPAL-WIDE CURFEW HOURS FROM TEN IN THE EVENING (10:00 P.M.) TO THREE IN THE MORNING (3:00 A.M.) IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF CALAMBA, MISAMIS OCCIDENTAL AS A MEASURE TO ADDRESS THE CONTINUOUS THREAT OF TRANSMISSION OF THE COVID-19 DURING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MODIFIED GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE (MGCQ)”**

**SECTION 2. PROHIBITED ACTS, PERIOD OF THE CURFEW, AND COVERED PERSONS.** It is hereby prohibited to loiter, wander, stroll, play or to remain or stay in public places within the territorial jurisdiction of the municipality without legal or justifiable reason during the period of the curfew from 10:00 o'clock in the evening to 3:00 o'clock in the morning of the following day. This ordinance shall cover all persons residing, working, studying, and visiting the municipality of Calamba. However, in cases where a localized barangay lockdown is declared by the Municipal Mayor, and concurred by the IATF, *curfew hours can be established by the Punong Barangays through an Ordinance*, as they see fit based on the current Covid-19 cases within their respective jurisdiction concerning guidelines of the localized community quarantine.

**SECTION 3. EXEMPTIONS.** The following shall be exempted from the implementation of this Ordinance:












- A. Those who work at night such as hospital personnel like doctors, nurses and other health personnel, ambulance drivers, security guards, and those who may be allowed by the Local Covid-19 Task Force herein created by the Municipality;
- B. Delivery of necessities like food and medicines;
- C. Public transport services (buses, tricycles, and the like) as determined by the Municipal Traffic and Management Committee;
- D. Peace and Order Personnel in both municipal and barangay levels as determined by the Local Chief Executive;
- E. Emergency cases or situations. This includes unforeseen circumstances, or the status or condition resulting therefrom, requiring immediate action to safeguard life, limb, or property. The term also includes, but is not limited to, fires, calamities, disasters, automobile accidents, or other similar circumstances.
- F. Authorized local government officials and employees such as the members of Emergency Response Teams, Peace and Order Personnel in the municipality as determined by the Local Chief Executive;
- G. Workers in essential businesses are allowed to travel in accordance with the IATF Guidelines.

**SECTION 4. ENFORCEMENT.** This Ordinance shall be primarily implemented by the PNP-Calamba MPS to be assisted by the following authorities: a) Punong Barangays and their respective Peace and Order personnel and/or Barangay Tanods; b) Municipal Ordinance and Enforcement Division, and c) Calamba Action Command.

**SECTION 5. GUIDELINES IN APPREHENSION.**

- A.) All apprehending officers shall wear their uniforms and proper identification at all times while on duty.

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- B.) Persons in violation of this Ordinance shall be immediately accompanied to his or her residence. *In case the violator is a minor*, the parents or guardian shall be notified by the apprehending officer, and the minor shall only be released to the said parents or guardian, without prejudice to the prosecution of the parents or guardians under the Code of Parental Responsibility.
- C.) Should the violator refuse to be accompanied to his or her residence, he or she shall be brought to the nearest police station for proper arrest and detention.
- D.) Any homeless, abandoned, or neglected person found in violation of this Ordinance shall be brought to the Municipal Social Welfare Development Department within twelve (12) hours from apprehension.

**SECTION 6. PENALTIES.** Any person found violating this Ordinance shall suffer the penalties as follows:


First Offense -----	P 1,000.00
Second Offense -----	1,500.00
Third Offense and Succeeding Violations ---	2,000.00

**SECTION 7. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** If any provision of this Ordinance is determined to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, its remaining provisions shall remain in full force as though the Ordinance did not originally include such invalid, illegal or unenforceable provision.

**SECTION 8. EFFECTIVITY.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately and shall remain in full force and effect during the Implementation of the Modified General Community Quarantine (MGCQ) In Calamba, Misamis Occidental.

Enacted on this 7<sup>th</sup> day of June 2020, in the Municipality of Calamba, Misamis Occidental.
